Applicants should be:

- in their final year of high school or CÉGEP (in QC) if the child of an LODD firefighter recognized by the Canadian Fallen Firefighters Foundation (the Foundation), or
- the spouse/common law of an LODD firefighter recognized by the Canadian Fallen Firefighters Foundation and living with the LODD firefighter at the time of their death.

CFFFEP has the sole authority to decide all questions regarding the award of scholarships.

To be eligible for consideration, applications must include:

- A fully completed and signed application.
- Proof of relationship to a firefighter whose line of duty death has or is being accepted by the Canadian Fallen Firefighters Foundation.
- An essay of up to 500 words describing your career aspirations based on your intended course of study, and any other information that will assist the selection committee in reviewing your application. All essays become the property of the Canadian Fallen Firefighters Foundation Education Program and may be used for purposes related to the CFFFEP or to further the goals and objectives of the Foundation.
- An essay of up to 250 words relating your personal circumstances (family, employment, economic situation, etc.) or other extenuating circumstances that may assist the selection committee.
- A letter of recommendation from a manager of the community or volunteer program.
- If feasible, a letter of recommendation from a senior fire service member in the community who is not related to the applicant.
- If a current student, a letter of recommendation from any of the students' teachers, principal or other school official (as applicable).
- Proof of academic standing.
- Proof of enrolment in a post-secondary institution.
- Proof of participation in extracurricular and/or volunteer activities, if applicable.
